- 1) The red vinyl child-size chair in the red classroom has red duct tape covering a tear and there are also areas where the stitching is coming loose and the padding underneath is exposed.
- The stitching along the edges of the black vinyl couch in the red classroom is coming loose and the padding underneath is exposed.
- 3) The stitching along the edges of the blue vinyl bench in the blue classroom is coming loose and the padding underneath is exposed.
- 4) The stitching along the edges of the blue vinyl couch in the yellow classroom is coming loose and the padding underneath is exposed.
