- (a) Have completed the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and been found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member; or
- (b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;
- 2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation; and
- 3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, the file for a staff member with a hire date of 9/14/20 did not contain verification that a Criminal Records Check had been conducted prior to the staff member working with children. The staff member was, at times, observed working alone with children. The staff member in charge acknowledged that a Criminal Records Check had not been initiated prior to the aforementioned staff member working at the center.

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, the file for a staff member with a hire date of 9/14/20 did not contain verification that a Criminal Records Check had been conducted prior to the staff member working with children. The staff member was, at times, observed working alone with children. The staff member in charge acknowledged that a Criminal Records Check had not been initiated prior to the aforementioned staff member working at the center.

400 - CPR/First Aid Coverage Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (3) For a child-care center licensed for infant, toddler, or preschool-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Infant and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) Infant and child first aid.
- (4) For a child-care center licensed for school-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) First aid.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, documentation verifying that at least one staff member present was certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in infant and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation, infant and child first aid, and adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation and first aid was not presented at the time of the inspection. The staff member in charge stated that staff members were certified in CPR and first aid, but documenation of the certification was not available at the time of the inspection.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the file for a staff member with hire date of 3/10/20 did not contain verification that the staff member had received six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment. The file for a staff member with a hire date of 6/23/14 did not contain verification that the staff member had completed one and one half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training within the last five (5) years. Review of ECE-TRIS also failed to verify completion of the aforementioned trainings. The staff member in charge stated that verification of the trainings was not available at the time of the inspection.

General: Based on observation, cleaning supplies labeled "Keep Out of Reach of Children" were located in an unlocked bathroom cabinet in the School Age Room.

Findings:

General: Based on observation of the younger children's playground, the protective surface did not sufficiently cover the ground under three (3) swings and one (1) slide. Observation of the older children's playground revealed the protective surface did not sufficiently cover the ground under three (3) swings and three (3) slides.

- (3) Rest time shall include adequate space specified by the child's age as follows:

- 1. An individual non-tiered crib that meets Consumer Product Safety Commission standards established in 16 C.F.R. 1219-1220;
- 2. A firm crib mattress in good repair with a clean tight-fitted sheet that shall be changed:
- a. Weekly; or
- b. Immediately if it is soiled or wet;

General: Based on observation of the Babies and Ones Room, an infant slept in an infant swing; therefore, the infant was not provided with a crib.

- (5) Frozen food shall be:
- (a) Kept at a temperature of zero degrees Fahrenheit or below; and
- (b) Thawed:

- 4. By another method in accordance with the Department of Public Health's food safety standards and permits, established in KRS Chapter 217.

General: Based on observation, two freezers located next to the kitchen did not contain a thermometer or other appropriate temperature-measuring device; therefore, the temperature of the freezers could not be determined.

922 KAR 2:405E. Emergency Regulation.

Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:405E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, upon the surveyor's arrival one staff member answered the door without wearing a face mask, and another staff member stood in the hallway without wearing a face mask. One staff member was observed to wear his/her face mask below his/her nose for the duration of the inspection. CDC guidelines state that a face mask should cover the nose and mouth and be secured under the chin.
