(1) A child-care center shall maintain:

(i) A written record of practiced fire drills conducted monthly detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A review of the 2017 fire drill log found no evidence of a fire drill conducted in July; therefore, drills are not conducted monthly. Furthermore, at the time of the survey (10/25/17) it was found that the fire drill for 11/3/17 had already been documented on the fire drill log, therefore the information documented was not accurate.
