Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements regarding safety. A circuit panel, located directly between the boys and girls restrooms, was open (unlatched) and accessible to students.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the childcare center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulations. Observation of the girl's bathroom revealed the air vent, located on the ceiling directly above the toilet, was covered with dust.

690 - Sink **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the childcare center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with state regulations. The sink in the Dr. Suess room failed to produce hot water at the time of the survey. During the inspection, the surveyor ran the water for several minutes and it never warmed to proper temperature.

695 - Toilet **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and
- (d) Have ventilation to outside air.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the childcare center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulations. Observation of the boy's bathroom revealed a small puddle of liquid under the urinal that was leaking from the connected white PVC pipe, and was covered in a black substance. **Hygienic Practices**

- (20) An outdoor play area shall be:
- (d) Safe from foreseeable hazard;
- (e) Well drained;
- (f) Well maintained;
- (g) In good repair; and
- (h) Visible to staff at all times.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the childcare center failed to maintain an outdoor play area in accordance with regulations. Observation of the outdoor play area revealed three (3) large gaps/holes between the wooden perimeter privacy fence and the ground, thus creating multiple entrapment hazards. Further observation of the outdoor play area revealed a large section of black weed barrier protruding up from the base of a tree. Continued observation of the outdoor play revealed a large tree branch lying on an adjacent sidewalk that leads to the access gate of the outdoor air conditioning and heating units. The branch was within reach of students as they enter the play area.
