General: Based on observation, a staff member was caring for sixteen children ages six to seven years old by herself from 3:14 p.m. until 3:23 p.m., when another staff member joined her. This individual was over ratio by one child.

General: Based on review of documentation, two staff members hired 8/27/2021 and 10/11/2021, did not have documentation of educational qualifications.

- A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, a staff member hired 10/11/2021 did not have a negative tuberculin skin result, nor a physician's statement clearing this individual of active tuberculosis in their personnel file. Additionally, a staff member hired 3/21/2017 had a negative tuberculin skin result dated 9/13/2019, and therefore exceeded two years and was no longer current.
