Based on a review of documentation it was found that the copy of the regulations available on site at the time of the survey were not current.

922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (e) A current personnel file for each child-care center staff person to include:
- 1. Name, address, date of birth, and date of employment;
- 2. Proof of educational qualifications;
- 3. Record of annual performance evaluation;
- 4. Documentation of compliance with tuberculosis screening in accordance with Section 11(1)(b) of this administrative regulation; and
- 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

Findings:

Based on interview it was found that the local school system has been on Fall Break all week and this location has been used for full day care. Further interview with the staff person in charge found that staff from the other after school programs within the system have been working at this location. Based on a review of documentation presented for review at the time of the survey it was found that not all staff files from the other locations contained all of the required employee records/documentation at this location.

390 - Educational Requirements

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:
- 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

Based on a review of documents presented for review at the time of the survey it was found that a staff person hired 11/10/17 did not have a copy of a high school diploma, GED or other qualifying documentation on file at the facility.

395 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

Based on a review of records submitted for review at the time of the survey it was found that a staff person hired 8/15/18 did not have the results of a T.B. skin test read until 8/27/18. The T.B. test was not completed prior to the staff person's date of hire.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

Based on a review ECE-Tris records and documentation presented for review at the time of the survey it was found that a staff person hired 2/27/17 took pediatric abusive head trauma training on 8/16/13 and did not renew the training until 9/7/17. A review of documents presented for review found a staff person hired 11/16/14 had not completed fifteen (15) hours of training for the 2016-2017 training year. Further review of documentation found a staff person hired 11/13/15 had only five (5) hours of training for the 2016-2017 training year.

Based on interview it was found that the facility has a third party agreement with the local school system to provide transportation. A review of documentation presented for review at the time of the survey did not include documentation to verify there is a third party agreement with the school system.

Based on interview it was found that the school system was on Fall Break for the week and the children attended all day. Based on observation it was found that there was not a daily schedule of activities posted for full day of care. The facility had a daily schedule posted for after school care only.
