922 KAR 2:110. Section 4. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

(1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:

(n) Assure that a person acting as a caregiver of a child in care shall not be left alone with a child, if the licensee has not received the results of the background checks as described in Section 3(1)(e)6 of this administrative regulation;

#### Findings:

General: Based on Observation, at the time of the survey there were two (2) staff present and with the children. A review of staff records found one (1) staff person hired 2/27/17 did not have the results of a criminal records check and child abuse and neglect check on file at the facility. There was no evidence on file a the facility to verify that the applications for either of these records checks had been submitted. This staff person was observed alone with the male children while the other staff person took the female children to the bathroom. The second staff person had a hire date of 3/13/17. A review of this staff person's file found the results of a criminal records check and the application for the results of a child abuse and neglect check. However, the child abuse and neglect check presented for review at the time of the survey did not have the results of the child abuse and neglect check on file. This staff person took a group of female children to the bathroom alone. Both staff were then observed supervising the entire group of children consisting of nineteen (19) children in the cafeteria. Let it be noted that neither staff had the results on file at the facility of both required records checks.

# 300 - Background checks/left alone Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 6. License Issuance.

- (5) An individual described in subsection (4) of this section shall:
- (a) Submit to background checks described in paragraph (b) of this subsection;
- (b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:
- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and
- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

## Findings:

General: Based on Observation, at the time of the survey there were two (2) staff present and with the children. A review of staff records found one (1) staff person hired 2/27/17 did not have the results of a criminal records check and child abuse and neglect check on file at the facility. There was no evidence on file a the facility to verify that the applications for either of these records checks had been submitted. This staff person was observed alone with the male children while the other staff person took the female children to the bathroom. The second staff person had a hire date of 3/13/17. A review of this staff person's file found the results of a criminal records check and the application for the results of a child abuse and neglect check. However, the child abuse and neglect check presented for review at the time of the survey did not have the results of the child abuse and neglect check on file. This staff person took a group of female children to the bathroom alone. Both staff were then observed supervising the entire group of children consisting of nineteen (19) children in the cafeteria. Let it be noted that neither staff had the results on file at the facility of both required records checks. In addition, the staff person hired 3/13/17 had the results of a criminal records check dated 3/15/17. This is after the date of hire and not prior to or on the date of hire.

- 1. Name, address, date of birth, and date of employment;
- 2. Proof of educational qualifications;
- 3. Record of annual performance evaluation;
- 4. Written record of training participation to include:
- a. The training source;
- b. Location:
- c. Date; and
- d. Number of clock hours completed;
- 5. Every two (2) years, a:
- a. Statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- b. Copy of negative tuberculin results; and
- 6. For a director, employee, volunteer, or any person with supervisory or disciplinary control over, or having unsupervised contact with, a child in care, the results of a:
  - a. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
  - b. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
  - c. Criminal records check from any previous state of residence completed once if:
  - (i) The individual resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
  - (ii) No criminal records check has been completed for the individual's previous state of residence; and
  - d. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry;

## Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, at the time of the survey a staff person hired 2/27/17 did not have documentation on file at the time of the survey that provided the staff person addresses and date of birth.

### 315 - Educational Requirements

## Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, there was one (1) staff person with a hire date of 2/27/17 who did not have a copy of a high school diploma, GED or other qualifying documentation on file at the facility at the time of the survey.

## 320 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

#### 922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
  - 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, found that a staff person hired 2/27/17 did not have the results of a T.B. test or statement from a health professional indicating the individual is free from the symptoms of T.B. on file at the facility. An additional staff person hired 3/13/17 had the results of a T.B. test read on 3/16/17. The T.B. test was not completed until after the staff person was hired.

## 330 - Adequate Substitute(s)

**Not In Compliance** 

#### 922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (6) Child-care centers shall have available in case of need:
- (a) One (1) qualified substitute staff person for a Type II child-care center; or
- (b) Two (2) qualified substitute staff persons for a Type I child-care center.

#### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, there were two (2) files under the tab labeled substitutes in the binder presented for review of documentation at the time of the survey. A review of the files of two (2) substitutes with a hire date of 4/7/17 found that neither file contained all required documentation. During the exit conference it was found through interview that neither of these staff are currently employed.

## 340 - Training Not In Compliance

#### 922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

## Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and ECE-TRIS records, found that the staff person named as director with a hire date of 10/10/14 only had evidence of having completed 8.75 hours of training for the 2016-2017 training year. There was no other documentation presented for review at the time of the survey that could verify additional training hours.

#### 360 - Electronic Viewing/Listening Devices

## 922 KAR 2:120. Section 2. Child Care Services.

- (4) The child-care center shall provide a daily planned program:
- (d) That offers a variety of creative activities including the follwoing:
- 12. Use of electronic viewing and listening devices if the:
- a. Material is appropriate to the child using the equipment;
- b. Material does not include any violence, adult content viewing, or inappropriate language;
- c. Viewing or individual listening is limited to two (2) hours per day;
- d. Viewing or listening is discussed with parents prior to viewing or listening; and
- e. Viewing or listening is designed as an educational tool.
- (5) A child who does not wish to use the electronic devices during the planned program shall be offered other appropriate activities.

#### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that written permission had been obtained from parents allowing their child to watch PG rated movies while in attendance at the facility. An interview with the staff person in charge found that since school started in August 2017 the children have watched the PG rated movie Holes and another PG rated movie but could not remember the name of the movie. The date these movies were watched could not be determined.

#### **Findings**

General: Based on Review of Documentation, out of ten (10) children's files reviewed there were two (2) children with ernollment dates of 8/1/17 and 9/22/17 who did not have evidence of a current immunization certificate on file.

1075 - Enrollment Information Not In Compliance

#### 922 KAR 2:110. Section 3. Records.

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (b) A written record for each child:
- 1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;
- 2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and
- 3 To contain
- a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;
- b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:
- (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
- (ii) Family physician; and
- (iii) Preferred hospital;
- c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
- d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
- (i) Allergies;
- (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency situation involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

#### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, out of ten (10) children's file reviewed there was one (1) child whose enrollment information did not include a preferred hospital.

- (e) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and
- (f) Daily schedule.

General: Based on Observation, at the time of the visit a daily schedule was not posted.
