#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain children's records in accordance with regulations. Review of ten (10) children's files revealed the written records for two (2) children enrolled 3/19/15 and 8/1/18 failed to contain contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's preferred hospital. Interview with staff in charge revealed this documentation was not on file at the time of survey.
