Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation revealed that the kitchen vent above the stove was coverred with grease and dust, making it unsanitary and unclean. Interview with the staff in charge confirmed the stove vent was in need of cleaning.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to post documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of presented posted documents revealed that each statement of deficiency for the current licensure year was not posted; Each plan of correction for the current licensure year was not posted. Review of postings and interview with the staff in charge revealed that the document was not posted nor presented for review.
