Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation presented, review of ECE-TRIS, and interview, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A staff file (DOH: 08/01/16) did not contain documentation of the completion of fifteen (15) hours of annual training for 08/01/18 07/31/19. Review of ECE-TRIS, revealed that only fourteen (14) hours of annual training had been completed.
- 2. A staff file (DOH: 02/28/18) did not contain documentation of the completion of fifteen (15) hours of annual training for 02/28/18 02/27/19. Review of ECE-TRIS, revealed that only seven and one-half (7 1/2) hours of annual training had been completed.

Upon interview, staff thought all trainings were up to date.
