<p>General: Based on interviews, three (3) caregivers, supervised a group of twenty-six (26) children, ages three (3) to five (5) years, while on the outdoor playground at 11:00 a.m. on 10/29/15. Interview revealed the children played together as one group when on the playground. The maximum group size should have been 24 children.</p>
