- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
 - (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
 - (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
 - (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Upon request, verification that a staff member with the hire date 09/09/2009 had completed fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and educational training was not presented for review on the day of the inspection. Review of the Early Care and Education Training Records Information System (ECE-TRIS) report did not verify that the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved training had been completed by the staff member.

- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and**
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.**
