General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement	t was not met. The following was found:	

1. The surveyor observed that the roll of toilet paper that the children used in the two year old classroom bathroom was stored in an unsanitary manner; positioned on the back of the toilet

2. The rolls of paper towels that the staff and children used in two classrooms (one year old classroom and four year old classroom) were stored in an unsanitary manner, positioned on the side of the sink. This method of storage promotes germs due to each staff person and child handling the roll to obtain a paper towel.

The staff person in charge reviewed information on her computer and then verbally identified 6/15/21 and 6/14/21 as the hire dates. However, the dates of hire were not maintained in the personnel files.
