## Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE-TRIS, the surveyor discovered the following:

- 1. A staff (DOH: 06/14/2021) completed nine and one half (9.5) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training from 06/14/2021- 06/13/2022.
- 2. A staff (DOH: 07/18/2021) failed to complete the required six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment in a childcare program; the staff completed orientation on 12/22/2021.
- 3. A staff (DOH: 03/14/2022) failed to complete the required six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment in a childcare program; the staff completed orientation on 06/20/2022.

Staff reported that she would have staff complete training in a timely manner.
