**350 - Health, Safety, Comfort** **Not In Compliance**

**922 KAR 2:090. Section 10. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.**  
**(1) A director shall:**  
**(I) Assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child;**

**Findings:**

General: Based on review of documentation, observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. On 2/28/19 the facility reported that on 2/27/19 at 10:50AM a child's finger was injured in an exterior door and medical care was required. The facility incident report stated that the children in the classroom were lining up to come inside at the time of the incident. A staff person opened the door slightly and let go of it to demonstrate to the children that it was heavy; therefore, would need two (2) children to hold it open. The child stuck her hand in the door at the same time that the staff person let go of it which caused her finger to get smashed between the door and the frame. Surgery was required to repair the injury.

**1135 - Immunization** **Not In Compliance**

**922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.**  
**(1) A child-care center shall maintain:**  
**(a) A current immunization certificate for each child in care within thirty (30) days of the child's enrollment, unless an attending physician or the child's parent objects to the immunization of the child pursuant to KRS 214.036;**

**Findings:**

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. One (1) child (enrollment date: 10/26/15) had an immunization certificate on file that was no longer current as of 2/28/19.
