General: Based on review of documentation, a staff hired on 08/07/19, a staff hired on 08/09/17, and a staff hired on 08/29/19, did not have education verification on file.

General: Based on review of documentation, a staff hired on 08/07/19, and a staff hired on 08/08/19, did not have TB documentation on file. A staff hired on 07/29/13, had TB documentation on file that was dated 09/18/17.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

General: Based on review of documentation, a staff hired on 10/23/17, had documentation of completing six (6) hours of cabinet approved training hours during the first year of employment. A staff hired on 08/04/16, had documentation of completing nine (9) hours of cabinet approved training hours during a subsequent year of employment. A staff hired on 08/04/16, had documentation of completing three (3) hours of cabinet approved training hours during a subsequent year of employment. A staff hired on 08/09/17, did not have documentation of completing any hours of cabinet approved training hours during a subsequent year of employment.

General: Based on observation, a bottle Claire Dust Up was stored in an open faced wooden unit in the cafeteria. A gallon of Pro-Texall Deluxe Foam was stored on the corner of the sink counter in the restroom of room 118. These items were both labeled, "Keep out of reach of children," but were accessible to children.

General: Based on observation, thirteen (13) extra-large empty plastic bags were stored on top of shelves and tables in room 114. Seven (7) extra-large empty plastic bags were stored on top of shelves and tables in room 118. Three (3) rolls of small plastic trash bags were stored in an open faced wooden unit holder on the wall in the cafeteria. These items were not a part of the planned program of instruction and were accessible to children.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

General: Based on observation, a large brown stain was on a ceiling tile in the school-age girls' restroom. Large brown stains were on two (2) ceiling tiles in the cafeteria.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the hot water temperature registered eighty (80) degrees Fahrenheit at three (3) sinks in the school-age girls' restroom. The hot water temperature registered eighty (80) degrees Fahrenheit at a sink in the school-age boys' restroom.
