- (b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:
- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and
- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

#### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a substitute staff member hired on 8/17/16 listed that she lived in Ohio on her CAN check within the last five (5) years. The facility did not have written evidence of completing an out of state background for this staff member. This staff member was not present at the facility; therefore, not working alone with the

(3) For a child-care center licensed for infant, toddler, or preschool-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:

- (a) Infant and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) Infant and child first aid.
- (4) For a child-care center licensed for school-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) First aid.

## Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the director and another staff member had current CPR training, but there was no written evidence of current first aid training. The CPR cards on site only listed current CPR training. The facility operates from 7:45 AM until 3:15 PM Monday through Friday. There is no one present with current first aid training during the facility's operational hours.

#### Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the facility had a Fisher Price climber with a slide sitting on a wooden plank floor in the outdoor shelter. The staff in charge indicated that the children use this space for outdoor gross motor activities. The climber was approximately 4.5 feet tall. The climber was not sitting on protective surfacing.
