- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. One person identified as a volunteer did not have evidence or results of a criminal records check (CRC) on file. His start date was identified as 8/12/15. The staff person in charge stated that this person is only at the facility a couple times a year and indicated that he is never alone with the children

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. An inspection of the facility refrigerator found that apple juice was the only drink present to serve to the children at lunch. The staff person in charge acknowledged the finding and stated that she was not aware that milk had to be served.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The statement of deficiencies and plan of correction from a 11/15/16 relicensure inspection was not posted.
