### 405 - TB Verification

### 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(1) Child-care center staff:

(b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:

1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, one staff hired on 1/1/20, did not have updated documentation of a negative TB test or a statement from a health care professional stating that the staff is free from active tuberculosis on file at the facility. The TB test on file for this staff expired on 1/20/22.

#### 435 - Training

### 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

(17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, one staff hired on 9/1/20, did not have the required 15 hours of annual training for the year. A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed this finding.
