Findings:		
General: Based on review of documentation, observation, and inte	erview, it was found that on 6/25/20, staff observed a three-	year-old child in care walking abnormally while on the

playground and while playing in the gross motor room. The provider called the child's parents to notify them of the situation. The child continued to play with other children and did not show signs of being in pain while at the facility. However, when the parent picked up the child and placed her on her hip to carry her to the car, the child screamed and cried out in pain. Later in the evening, the parent took the child to the hospital to be examined and the child was referred to be examined by an orthopedic physician the next day. The child was diagnosed with an impact injury to her left hip. The physician viewed video footage of the child jumping from a rock climbing structure on the playground two days prior (6/23/20), and identified it as the likely cause of the injury. The physician stated that pain and discomfort from this type of injury typically does not show up until a few days later.
