General: Based on Review of Documentation, staff hired on 10/30/17, 02/01/15 and 09/01/15 did not have documentation from a health care professional stating they were free of active tuberculosis.

General: Based on Interview, no staff working for the facility is certified in CPR/First Aid.

- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

General: Based on Review of Documentation, staff hired on 02/01/15, 09/02/14, 11/30/15 and 10/01/16 did not have the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training on file. Staff hired on 02/01/15 also did not have the required Orientation I and II clas or the Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma class on file. This information was verified through ECETRIS.

A large stain was found on the carpet in the hallway next to the infant classroom as well as a section of torn carpet inside the infant classroom. Several of the slats to the floor vent in the two-year-old classroom were missing. The opening was large enough for a child's hand to fit through the vent.
