Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

1. A bottle of Germ-X placed on a desk in Classroom 2041B that stated "Keep Out of the Reach of Children" on the back label. The Germ-X was observed to be within reach of the children.

2. A skyjack located inside the Gym and observed to be accessible to the children. The surveyor observed children from Classroom 2041A inside the Gym upon arrival at the childcare center. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that the skyjack was recently placed inside the Gym the day before the surveyor's visit. Staff-in-charge stated that maintenance was working on the sound system and that the skyjack does not stay inside the Gym. Staff-in-charge stated that the children will not utilize the Gym until the skyjack is removed.
