Findings:
General: Based on Review of Documentation, six staff, hired 1/9/17, 5/24/16, 7/26/16, 3/14/16, 3/16/15 and 8/3/16, did not have documentation of their education on file.

 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

Findings:
General: Based on Review of Documentation, staff hired 1/9/17, 7/26/16 and 3/14/16, did not have TB documentation on file. Staff hired 10/27/14, TB documentation was dated 5/5/14; staff hired 8/15/15, TB documentation was dated 9/2/14, and staff hired 10/27/14, TB documentation was dated 3/28/14.

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, no one present with the children in bldg #2, from 7:15 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., was currently certified in infant and child first aid.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, three (3) staff hired 5/24/16, 7/26/16 and 10/27/14, respectively, completed orientation training on 2/13/17, 2/27/17 and 3/13/16, which was not within the first three (3) months of their employment.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, three (3) children each enrolled on 3/17/15, 9/4/15 and 5/6/16, did not have physician's information on file. Two (2) children each enrolled on 3/21/16 and 10/21/16, did not have the name of the preferred hospital and the physician's name listed. Also, a child enrolled 10/21/16, did not have a signed emergency authorization on file.

General: Based on Interview, there was no written record that detailed the children who participated in the fire drill conducted during February 2017. Interview determined the drill was conducted, but the names of the children participants were not documented.
