General: Based on Observation, paint along the baseboard of the wall, in the 18-month to 24-month-olds' room, was chipped, bubbled and accessible to children in care.

General: Based on Observation and interview, the ventilation fan was not operable in the two-year-olds' restroom. The director was unaware the fan was not working.

- 5. Easily cleaned; and
- 6. Free of any items not used for diaper changing.

## Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the changing pad, in the one-year-olds' room, had a one inch tear.

First Aid/Medication Not In Compliance

730 - Medication Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 7. First Aid and Medicine.

- (6) Medication, including refrigerated medication, shall be:
- (a) Stored in a separate and locked place, out of the reach of a child unless the medication is:
- 1. A first aid supply and is maintained in accordance with subsection (1) of this section;
- 2. Diaper cream, sunscreen, or toothpaste. Diaper cream, sunscreen, or toothpaste shall be inaccessible to a child;
- 3. An epinephrine auto-injector. In accordance with KRS 199.8951:
- a. An epinephrine auto-injector shall be inaccessible to a child;
- b. A child-care center shall have at least one person onsite who has received training on the administration of an epinephrine auto-injector if the child-care center maintains an epinephrine auto-injector;
  - c. A child-care center shall seek emergency medical care for a child if an auto-injector is administered to the child; and
- d. A child-care center shall report to the child's parent and the cabinet in accordance with 922 KAR 2:090, Section 12 if an epinephrine autoinjector is administered to a child; or
- 4. An emergency or rescue medication for a child in care, such as medication to respond to diabetic or asthmatic condition, as prescribed by the child's physician. Emergency or rescue medication shall be inaccessible to a child in care;
- (b) Kept in the original bottle; and
- (c) Properly labeled.
- (7) Medication shall not be given to a child if the medication's expiration date has passed.

General: Based on Observation, two (2) bottles of children's pain and fever medicine were in the locked medicine case and were not labeled to indicate to whom each belonged.

## **Outdoor Play Area**

General: Based on Observation, three (3) swings in the large outdoor play area and a slide in the small outdoor play area had dirt underneath.

- 2. A firm crib mattress in good repair with a clean tight-fitted sheet that shall be changed:
- a. Weekly; or
- b. Immediately if it is soiled or wet;

General: Based on Observation, a crib mattress, in the nursery, had a one inch tear, and the sheet on another crib mattress was loose in the nursery.

# 795 - Individual Bed/Mat/Cot and Bedding

- (3) Rest time shall include adequate space specified by the child's age as follows:
- (b) For a toddler or preschool-age child:
- 1. An individual bed, a two (2) inch thick waterproof mat, or cot in good repair; and
- 2. Bedding that is in good repair and is changed:
- a. Weekly; or
- b. Immediately if it is soiled or wet.

#### Findings:

General: Based on Observation, a nap mat, in the eighteen-month-olds' room, was torn with foam exposed.

815 - Toys/Furniture Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 11. Toys and Furnishings.

- (1) All toys and furniture contacted by a child shall be:
- (a) Kept clean and in good repair; and
- (b) Free of peeling, flaking, or chalking paint.

## Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the Plexi-glass, on two (2) cribs in the nursery and one (1) crib in the one-year-olds' room, was smeared with hand prints.
