Findings:

General: Review of the presented employee records revealed a staff member with hire date 11/4/16 whose file did not contain documentation to verify completion of the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training. Review of ECE-TRIS verified that the staff member did not complete fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training. Upon request, the staff member in charge did not present training documentation for the aforementioned staff member at the time of the survey.

Findings:

General: There was not any toy food available for the children to use with the toy kitchen located in the Toddler Room at the time of the survey. The staff member working in the Preschool Room at the time of the survey acknowledged that there was not any toy food available to use with the toy kitchen.

- (1) All toys and furniture contacted by a child shall be:
- (a) Kept clean and in good repair; and

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child-care center failed to meet the requirement.

- 1 The inside of the bottle warmer located in the Infant Room was soiled with a brown substance at the time of the survey.
- 2) The door was broken off the blue, yellow and green toy kitchen located in the Preschool Room exposing the sharp metal hinges.
- 3) The bottom metal portion around the chalkboard located in the Preschool Room was bent away from the chalkboard, exposing sharp metal pieces.

Findings:

General: Review of the presented children's records revealed the following:

- 1) The files for four (4) children (enrollment dates 9/1/16, 8/9/16 and two (2) with the same enrollment date of 8/8/16) did not contain the child's general health status and medical history including allergies and restrictions on the child's participation in activities.
- 2) Continued review of the presented children's records revealed a child with enrollment date 1/21/16 whose file did not contain authorization by the parent for the child care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence.

Upon request, the staff member in charge did not present the requested documentation for the aforementioned children at the time of the survey.
