General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found ten (10) children's files did not have a preferred hospital documented for staff to contact if the children need emergency medical treatment. Staff stated they would update their enrollment forms.

(5) New staff shall: (a) Undergo name-based background checks upon hiring; (b) Not be left alone with children until the name-based background checks have been approved and returned; and (c) Undergo fingerprint-based background checks pursuant to 922 KAR 2:280 once the checks are operational again.
