General: Based on review of documentation, staff hired on 08/30/2021 did not have education documentation on file.

General: Based on review of documentation, staff hired on 08/30/2021 did not have documentation on file from a health care professional stating that she was free of active tuberculosis.

General: Based on observation, an infant was found asleep in a bouncy seat in Room 104. Staff person stated that the child had been asleep for approximately ten minutes.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the blue child size couch in Room 114 had a large tear along the front edge exposing the foam padding under the fabric.

865 - Indoor/Outdoor Equipment

(2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:

- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;

General: Based on observation, there was caution tape wrapped completely around one of the playground sets. Staff stated that the equipment was going to be replaced soon but was not certain what was wrong with the equipment.
