b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:

(i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;

(ii) Family physician; and

(iii) Preferred hospital;

c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;

d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:

(i) Allergies;

(ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and

- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;

f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Review of ten (10) children's files revealed that two (2) files did not contain the parents' preferred hospital and preferred physician. Contiued review of the children's files revealed one (1) child's file did not contain the parents' information of a preferred hospital. Further review of the children's files revealed ten (10) that did not have a written record completed and signed by the child's parent, identifying information about the child, which includes authorization by the parent's for the child care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absences.
