# Findings:

General: Based on Observation, during a tour of the one-year-old room and the infant room copies of menus were observed posted on the wall. A child's name was written at the top of the menus and comments such has "Doctor thinks he is lactose intolerant" and other informantion regarding the meals was written on the menu. There were only a few children who had such items posted. These menus were within view of anyone entering the classrroom. There was no documentation on file to verify that the parents of the children had given written concent to have such information posted regarding their child. The staff person in charge acknowledged this and stated that some parents don't want their child eating certain things on the menu and will bring food to replace those items they don't want their child to eat.
