### **General Administration**

115 - Reports to Cabinet Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Reports.

- (1) The following shall be reported to the cabinet or designee and other agencies specified in this section within twenty-four (24) hours from the time of discovery:
  - (a) Communicable disease, which shall also be reported to the local health department pursuant to KRS 214.010;
  - (b) An accident or injury to a child that requires medical care;
  - (c) An incident that results in legal action by or against the child-care center that affects a child or staff person;
  - (d) An incident involving fire or other emergency; or
  - (e) A report of child abuse or neglect that:
  - 1. Has been accepted by the cabinet in accordance with 922 KAR 1:330; and
- 2. Names a director, employee, volunteer, or person with supervisory or disciplinary control over, or having unsupervised contact with a child in care as the alleged perpetrator.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, a child injured on 11-6-12 at the center received medical treatment for his injury at a dentist on 11-6-12 and the center failed to report this incident to the Cabinet.

## **Programming**

#### 410 - Infant/Toddler Combined with Older Children

**Not In Compliance** 

922 KAR 2:120. Section 5. Infant and Toddler Play Requirements.

(2) Except in accordance with subsection (3) of this section, an infant or toddler shall participate in an activity with an older child for no more than one (1) hour per day.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, a one year old child enrolled on 6-3-13 has been in the two year old classroom since his enrollment date and does not have a transition plan in place.
