- a. Ensures the child is within scope of vision and range of voice; or
- b. For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice;

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that a staff person used her cell phone from 2:39 p.m. until 2:45 p.m. while supervising children during nap time.

- (1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall: (e) Manage the staff in their individual job descriptions;
- (f) Develop child-care center plans, policies, and procedures;
- (g) Supervise staff conduct to ensure implementation of program policies and procedures;

# Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation recorded on video on 11/12/15, the surveyor found that a staff person used her cell phone from 2:39 p.m. until 2:45 p.m. while supervising children during nap time. Review of the Cell Phone/Phone Use policy states "Do not use your cell phone while you are responsible for children. Failure to do so could result in you being sent home for the day or your job being terminated. Remember, you are at KBK II to work, not be on your phone".

420 - Infant Sleep Position **Not In Compliance** 

922 KAR 2:120. Section 6. Sleeping and Napping Requirements.

(1) An infant shall sleep or nap on the infant's back unless the infant's health professional signs a waiver that states the infant requires an alternate sleeping position.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation during a tour of the child care center, the surveyor found that an infant child was sleeping on a Boppy Pillow. There was no documentation in the child's enrollment file that indicated the need for an altered sleep position.

### **Children's Records**

1070 - Immunization **Not In Compliance** 

922 KAR 2:110. Section 3. Records.

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (a) A current immunization certificate for each child in care within thirty (30) days of the child's enrollment, unless an attending physician or the child's parent objects to the immunization of the child pursuant to KRS 214.036;

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that a child's (DOE: 07/23/15) enrollment file did not contain an immunization certificate.
