Findings: Based on observation, the surveyor observed a large piece of plywood to be covering a hole in the ceiling in a room next to the kitchen area. The surveyor also observed stains on the ceiling in other rooms of the facility where there had been previous leaks. In an interview with the director and owner of daycare, the surveyor was informed that the owner of the building lives out of the country and does not take care of the maintenance of the building. The condition of the building creates a health, safety, and comfort issue for the children.

Findings: General: Based on observation, the surveyor found a large piece of plywood to be screwed into the ceiling in a room located next to the kitchen. The plywood was being used to cover a large hole in the ceiling.	
520 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings	Not In Compliance
922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements. (9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.	
Findings: General: Based on observation, the surveyor observed the carpets on the stairwell leading to the two-year-old classroom to be heavily soiled with several dark spots. The carpet inside the two-year-old classroom had a few dark spots on it as well. In an interview with staff, the surveyor was informed that the carpets are vacuumed daily.
