General: Based on review of documentation, the file for a staff member hired 11/20/2018 did not contain a negative tuberculin skin result or a physician's statement clearing this individual of active tuberculosis.

(8) Each center shall ensure that every staff member has received training on first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, a staff member hired 11/10/2015 did not have evidence of CPR and First Aid administration training.

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one

and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

(17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, a staff member hired 11/10/2015 had last taken Pediatric Abusive Head Training on 2/5/2016. This training is to be taken every five years. A review of ECE-TRIS supports this finding.
