The child was asleep in a crib and was discovered by another caregiver who entered the room. The responsible caregiver forgot the child was in the room.</p>

(1) A director shall: (e) Manage the staff in their individual job descriptions; (f) Assure the development, implementation, and monitoring of child-care center plans, policies, and procedures; (g) Supervise staff conduct to ensure implementation of program policies and procedures;</p> <p>Findings: General: Based on video observation, the director failed to ensure staff implemented the policies/procedures pertaining to supervision and reporting incidents to when a caregiver left a sleeping nine-month-old infant, alone in the dark, in the infant 2 room, for approximately twenty-five (25) minutes on 5/23/22.</p> <p>The center's supervision policy states an adult staff member shall supervise the children at all times and reports should be made within twenty-four (24) hours of discovery. The center's reporting incidents policy shall be reported immediately to the director and an incident/accident report shall be completed within (24) hours.</p>
