General: Based on Review of Documentation, caregiver hired 9/6/16, did not have her education verification on file.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, caregiver hired 9/6/16, did not TB documentation on file.

340 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
 - (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, caregivers hired 7/24/15 and 7/27/15, completed orientation training on 11/24/15 and a caregiver hired 8/24/15, completed orientation training on 12/21/15; therefore, these caregivers did not complete orientation training within the first three (3) months of their employment. Also, staff hired 7/27/15, had not completed any training hours.

General: Based on Interview, fire drill for October 2016, was conducted but the names of the children who participated were not documented.

- 1. Current rates for child care; and
- 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the center did not have their statement of deficiencies/plan of correction (SOD/POC) posted for the current licensure year. Interview with the director determined she failed to make a copy of the current SOD/POC.
