General: Based on review of documentation, a substitute caregiver hired on 8/21/20, did not have a processed criminal records check on file. Therefore, the center did not have two (2) qualified substitute staff persons.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, thirty-six (36) ceiling tiles were soiled with a brown stain in the cafeteria. Three (3) ceiling tiles were soiled with a brown stain and one (1) ceiling tile was soiled with a black stain in the girls' restroom across from the gym. Four (4) ceiling tiles were soiled with a brown stain in the boys' restroom across from the gym. Interview determined the roof last leaked during 2019.

General: Based on review of documentation, ten (10) children enrolled on 8/13/20, 3/9/20, 3/10/19, 8/25/20, 8/27/20, 8/20/20, 3/12/20, 3/16/20, 7/14/20, and 8/11/20, did not have authorization, on file, by the parent for the center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence.

A caregiver hired on 8/21/20, did not have a processed criminal records check on file.
