General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that the childcare center's liability insurance policy had an expiration date of 10/05/17. An updated insurance policy was not available for review

(5) An individual described in subsection (4) of this section shall:

- (a) Submit to background checks described in paragraph (b) of this subsection;
- (b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:
- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and
- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

## Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that the file for a staff (DOH: 11/02/17) contained a criminal records background check. The payment date on the background check was 11/08/17; thus, it was not submitted prior to or on the date of hire.

#### 330 - Adequate Substitute(s) Not In Compliance

#### 922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (6) Child-care centers shall have available in case of need:
- (a) One (1) qualified substitute staff person for a Type II child-care center; or
- (b) Two (2) qualified substitute staff persons for a Type I child-care center.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that the Type I childcare center has two (2) substitute staff persons. However, only one (1) staff person meets qualification based on the lack of fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved annual training.

#### 335 - Qualified Substitute **Not In Compliance**

## 922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (7) Each qualified substitute staff person shall:
  - (a) Meet the staff requirements of this administrative regulation; and
  - (b) Provide the required documentation to verify compliance with this administrative regulation.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that the Type I childcare center has two (2) substitute staff persons. However, only one (1) staff person meets qualification based on the lack of fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved annual training.

#### 340 - Training **Not In Compliance**

#### 922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE-TRIS, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. No verification was found that a staff (DOH: 07/18/16) completed one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training
- 2. Verification of only eleven (11) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training was found for a staff (DOH: 11/24/15).

General: Based on observation during a tour of the childcare center, the surveyor found that the size of the furniture in the school-age room was for preschool-age children. Per conversation with the Director, the surveyor learned that few school-age children are enrolled in the program. Furniture for school-age children was not available, although, a nineyear-old child was present during the renewal visit.

- (c) Other clean surfaces; or
- (d) If maintained in a sanitary condition, in nonabsorbent labeled containers a minimum of (6) six inches off the floor.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation during a tour of the kitchen, the surveyor found cookies and cereal were stored on the bottom base of a brown cabinet. The cookies and cereal were stored approximately three (3) inches from the floor rather than six (6) inches per regulation.

## Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. No verification was found that earthquake drills were conducted during the first, second and third quarters of 2017.
- 2. Verification was found that tornado drills were conducted during the first, second and third quarters of 2017. However, the times of the drills were not recorded.

# 1120 - Fire Drills Not In Compliance

## 922 KAR 2:110. Section 3. Records.

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (i) A written record of practiced fire drills conducted monthly detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found verification that fire drills were conducted from January 2017 through November 2017; however, the times that the drills were conducted were not recorded.

## 1145 - Earthquake/Tornado Drills

- (13) An earthquake drill and a tornado drill shall be conducted during hours of operation:
- (a) At least quarterly; and

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found no verification that earthquake drills were conducted during the first, second and third quarters of 2017.
