General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) One (1) electrical outlet in the preschool room without a protective cover.
- (2.) A broom and a dust pan was accessible to the children in the indoor gross motor room.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) Staff's (DOH: 10/22/18) file did not contain a statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis or a copy of a negative tuberculin result.
- (2.) Staff's (DOH: 1/7/19) file did not contain a statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis or a copy of a negative tuberculin result.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE – TRIS, the surveyor found that staff (DOH: 8/3/15) obtained three (3) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet – approved early care and education training.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) Two (2) round dark blue rugs located in the preschool room contained debris; therefore, the premises was not kept clean.
- (2.) The carpet located in the indoor gross motor room was stained in several different areas.
- (3.) The indoor gross motor room contained debris on the carpet; therefore, the carpet was not kept clean.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found a tear in the dry wall of the indoor gross motor room.

640 - Toilet Room Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (2) A toilet room shall:
- (a) 1. Be provided for each gender; or
- 2. A plan shall be implemented to use the same toilet room at separate times;
- (b) Have a supply of toilet paper; and
- (c) Be cleaned and disinfected daily.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found toilet paper on the floor of the restroom; therefore, the restroom was not clean.

650 - Toilet Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and
- (d) Have ventilation to outside air.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the toilet in the restroom contained urine, feces, and dirty toilet paper; therefore, the toilet was not kept in a clean condition.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the temperature in the kitchen's freezer was ten (10) degrees Fahrenheit; therefore, the temperature was not at the required zero degrees Fahrenheit or below.

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that nine (9) children's arrival times were documented on the daily attendance record; however, there were a total of eleven (11) children present.

1175 - Earthquake/Tornado/Fire Drills

 (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (h) A written record of quarterly practiced earthquake drills and tornado drills detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;
- (i) A written record of practiced fire drills conducted monthly detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) A written record of the December 2018 fire drill was not documented.
- (2.) A list of children who participated in the fire, earthquake, and tornado drills were not documented for the year of 2018.

1195 - Fire Drills Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

- (12) A fire drill shall be:
- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least monthly; and
- (b) Documented.
- (13) An earthquake drill and a tornado drill shall be:
- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least quarterly; and
- (b) Documented.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found a fire drill for December 2018 was not documented. Staff reported the fire drill was not conducted.
