Observation of the girl's bathroom revealed a can of Glade air freshener labeled "Keep Out of Reach of Children", located on a small table next to the toilet and accessible to the children in care.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to post documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of posted documentation revealed a statement of civil penalty received in the current licensure year was not posted. The staff member in charge acknowledged that the documentation was not posted at the time of the survey.
