(3)(a) Each center shall maintain a child-care program that assures each child will be:

- 1. Provided with adequate supervision at all times by a qualified staff person who:
- a. Ensures the child is within scope of vision and range of voice; or
- b. For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and interview the child care center failed to comply with supervision regulatory requirements. Review of documentation at the facility on 10/8/15 revealed there was a fire drill on 9/17/15. Continued review of documentation revealed two (2) employees typed and signed a statement on 9/17/15, stating that a child was left inside the building during the fire drill. Further review of documentation revealed two (2) employees were terminated due to leaving a child unsupervised inside a classroom during a fire drill conducted on 9/17/15. Interview with an employee on 10/26/15, revealed she observed the two (2) aforementioned employees counting their children outside and that one (1) of them stated that they were short of a child. Further interviewing revealed an employee had to unlock the doors to the facility to allow an employee back inside of the building to get the child who was left inside. Continued interviewing revealed a three-year-old was left alone inside Classroom B for approximately four (4) minutes until a staff member went back inside of the facility to retrieve the child.
