- (2) Except in accordance with subsection (3) of this section or Section 2(2)(c) of this administrative regulation, an infant or toddler under twentyfour (24) months of age shall not participate in an activity with an older child for no more than one (1) hour per day.
- (3) If a toddler is developmentally appropriate for a transition to a preschool age group, a toddler may participate in an activity with an older child for more than one (1) hour per day if:
- (a) Space for the toddler is available in the preschool-age group;
- (b) The staff-to-child ratios and group sizes are maintained based on the age of the youngest child;
- (c) The center has a procedure for listing a transitioning toddler on attendance records, including a specific day and time the toddler is with either age group; and
- (d) The child care center has obtained the signature and approval of the toddler's parent on the toddler's transition plan.

General: Based on observation and interview during a tour of the facility, there were 10 children in Room 227. An interview with staff found that the ages of the children ranged from two- to four-years-old. An interview with the staff person in charge found that children who are two-years-old remain in the classroom all day with the older children. It was also discovered through interview that there was not a transition plan on file for these children. Children who are two-years-old and combined in a classroom with older children must have a written permission plan as outlined in this regulation and the signture and approval of the child's parent. It should be noted that there is not a classroom designated specifically for children who are two-years-old.

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:
- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;
- (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;
- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation while inspecting the boys' bathroom located in the hallway, white tape was observed wrapped around the faucet in one of the sinks. The surveyor brought this to the attention of the staff person in charge. It was found that the faucet was loose but still operable. The staff person in charge indicated during interview she was unaware the faucet was loose. It was also stated that the program shares the bathroom with the elementary school children. This regulation requires that all indoor and outdoor equipment be in good repair. Due to the faucet being loose, it is not considered in good repair.

- (18) A snack shall include two (2) of the following:
- (a) Milk;
- (b) Protein;
- (c) Bread; or
- (d)1. Fruit;
- 2. Vegetable; or
- 3. 100 percent juice.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview, and review of documentation, the facility provides snack for the children. A review of the posted snack menu found that vanilla wafers and Motts Assorted Fruit Snacks was listed to be served for one of the days in the month of January 2020. The label on the box of Motts fruit snacks indicates the product contains real fruit and vegetable juice. However, the lable does not state that each pouch contains a serving of a fruit or vegetable. This indicates that the snack served on this particular day does not contain the required components for snack. In addition, graham crackers and marshmellows were listed for snack on another day in January 2020. Marshmellows do not meet the requirement as a component for snack.
