Findings:

General: Based on observation a caregiver's jacket, which hung on a hook on the side of the cubbies used by children, was approximately two (2) feet from the floor and was accessible to children in the pre-k room.

Findings

General: Based on observation, a roll of black plastic trash bags were stored in a compartment of a two (2) foot tall storage shelf in the two-year-olds' room. The roll of plastic bags was not a part of the planned program of instruction and was accessible to children.

- (b) Conform to hygienic practices while on duty;
- (c) Except as established in paragraph (d) of this subsection, wash their hands with liquid soap and running water:
- 1. Upon arrival at the center;
- 2. After toileting or assisting a child in toileting;
- 3. Before and after diapering each child;
- 4. After wiping or blowing a child's or own nose;
- 5. After handling animals;
- 6. After caring for a sick child;
- 7. Before and after feeding a child or eating;
- 8. Before dispensing medication;
- 9. After smoking or vaping; and

General: Based on observation, a staff member failed to wash her hands with liquid soap and warm running water before putting on gloves and diapering a child in the infants' room.
