- 1. Verification of only twelve (12) hours of cabinet approved early care and education annual training was found for a staff (DOH: 08/20/11) for the review period of 08/20/16 through 08/19/17.
- 2. Verification of only eleven and one-half (11 1/2) hours of cabinet approved early care and education annual training was found for a staff (DOH: 03/31/14) for the review period of 03/31/17 through 03/30/18.
- 3. Two (2) staff (DOH: 08/09/10 and 08/20/11) completed one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training on 11/29/11. The staff's pediatric abusive head trauma training was no longer current as of 11/28/16.
