# Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discovered a staff's (DOH: 08/20/2011) personnel file contained a negative tuberculin (TB skin test) dated for 04/17/2020; therefore, the TB verification was no longer current. The surveyor was unable to verify if the staff person was free of active tuberculosis.

Staff reported that she would have the staff member bring in a current negative TB skin test.

- (b) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids; and
- (c) Personal belongings and medications of staff.

# Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found an ashtray with two (2) cigarette butts in it placed beside the exit door outside on the playground. The surveyor observed a staff member remove the ashtray from the blue plastic chair and place it in the blue trash can located by the exit door.

Provider was issued a deficiency on 05/12/2021 stating, " an ashtray with a cigarette butt inside of it placed beside the exit door on the playground." Provider reported on the Plan of Correction, "ashtray has been removed and will be stored out of reach of children at all times monitor daily to make sure."

Staff reported that she would find a place to put the ashtray.

# 625 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

# 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. In the Two Year Old Classroom, there was a brown substance on a ceiling tile located in the corner of the classroom; therefore, the ceiling tile was not in good repair.
- 2. In the School Age Classroom, there was a brown substance on a ceiling tile located at the front of the classroom; therefore, the ceiling tile was not in good repair.
- 3. In the School Age Classroom, there were two (2) ceiling tiles that appeared to be off the ceiling grid; therefore, the ceiling was not in good repair.

Staff reported that she would fix the ceiling tiles.

695 - Toilet Not In Compliance

# 922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and
- (d) Have ventilation to outside air.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the toilet seat moved easily and was not tightly secured to the toilet in the first restroom near the back exit door.

Provider was issued a deficiency on a 05/12/2021 survey which stated that the toilet seat moved easily and was not tightly secured to the toilet in the first and second restroom near the back exit door. Provider reported, "toilet seat was tighten up and will monitor daily to make sure still not loose."

Staff reported that she would have the toilet seat tightened.
