- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

## Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of presented staff files revealed a staff member with the hire date 8/18/16 did not have written documentation from a health care professional to verify that the individual was free from active TB. Interview with the director revealed she was unable to locate the document.

340 - Training **Not In Compliance** 

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of presented staff files and ECE-TRIS revealed a staff member with the hire date 8/18/16 did not complete six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within ninety (90) days of

Review of presented staff files and ECE-TRIS revealed a staff member with the hire date 8/13/13 did not complete fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. Interview with the director revealed she was not able to verify the training hours were completed.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain written documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. The presented earthquake and tornado drill documentation form revealed the child care center did not have written documentation of earthquake and tornado drills conducted for the fourth quarter of 2016 and first quarter of 2017. Interview with the director revealed the earthquake and tornado drills had been conducted; however, she was unable to locate the documentation for the date, time and children who participated in the drills.

1120 - Fire Drills Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 3. Records.

(1) A child-care center shall maintain:

(i) A written record of practiced fire drills conducted monthly detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain written documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. The presented fire drill form revealed the child care center did not have written documentation of the fire drills conducted for September 2016 and December 2016. Interview with the director revealed the fire drills had been conducted; however, she was unable to locate the documentation for the date, time and children who participated in the drills.
