General: Based on observation, the infant/toddler caregiver wore gloves but failed to wash her hands after she diapered a child.

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the time of each dosage, the date and amount of medication were not documented for a child who received Guangacie on 05/30/17 and 05/22/17; a child who received Methylphenidate on 05/22/17, and a child who received Albuterol on 09/07/16. Also, the date and amount of medication were not documented for a child who received acetaminephen on 01/19/17.
