922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation including the Training Records Information Systems (TRIS) the following was found:

1.) One (1) staff file (hire date 10/20/03) did not contain evidence of current pediatric abusive head trauma training. Document present in file was no longer valid after 4/30/19.

2.) One (1) staff file (hire date 10/23/17) did not contain the required (15) hours of annual training.
