General: Based on observation, the surveyor found six (6) children in the Toddler Classroom. Based on review of documentation of the center's diagram, the Toddler Classroom is approved by DRCC for a total capacity of five (5) children; therefore, the minimum of thirty-five square feet per child was not in compliance.

- (1.) A toilet seat was loose on the toilet in the restroom located in the Two to Five Year Olds Classroom; therefore, the toilet was not in good repair.
- (2.) A toilet contained urine and feces in the restroom located in the Two to Five Year Olds Classroom; therefore, the toilet was not kept clean.
