General: Based on review of documentation, a staff member (DOH: 10/8/15) did not complete a total of nine (9) hours of approved training as required. A review of ECE-TRIS found that the staff member had obtained one and one half (1 1/2) hour of training during the annual training year of 10/8/15-10/8/16. A review of the staff member's file found no additional training documentation.

General: Based on observation, during a tour of the preschool classroom the surveyor observed a partially empty, plastic bottle of Dr. Pepper brand soda to be sitting on top of the children's cubbies. The soda was accessible to the children.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the recorded date, time, and names of children who participated in monthly fire drills from January 2016 through November 2016 were not available for review.

1140 - Fire Drills Not In Compliance

- (b) Documented.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, there were no records available for review to verify that fire drills had been completed monthly from January 2016 through November 2016.
