1135 - Immunization

922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.

(1) A child-care center shall maintain:

(a) A current immunization certificate for each child in care within thirty (30) days of the child's enrollment, unless an attending physician or the child's parent objects to the immunization of the child pursuant to KRS 214.036;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain children's records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of the presented children's records revealed children files with the same enrollment date of 10/3/16 that did not contain a current immunization certificate. Upon request, the staff member in charge did not present current immunization certificates for the aforementioned children at the time of the survey.
